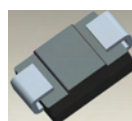

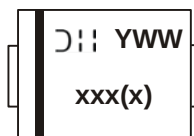

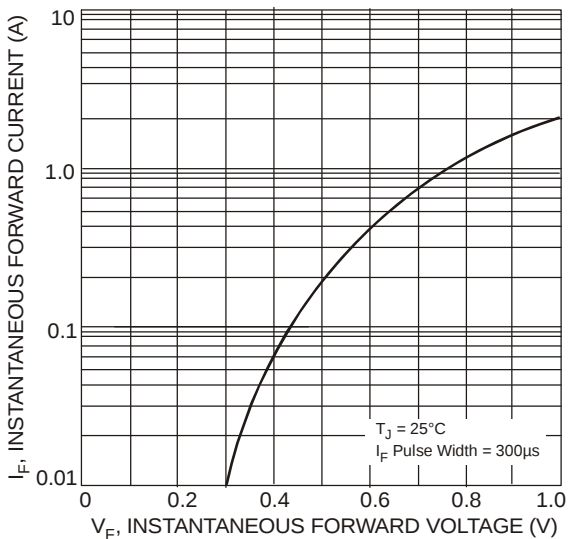


Fig. 1 Typical Forward Characteristics

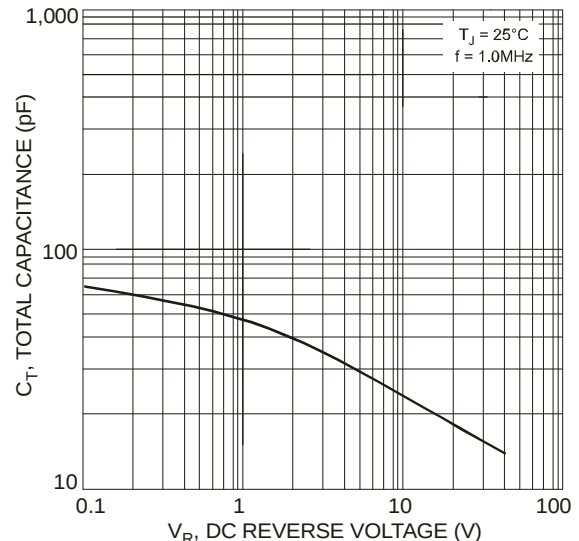


Fig. 2 Total Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage

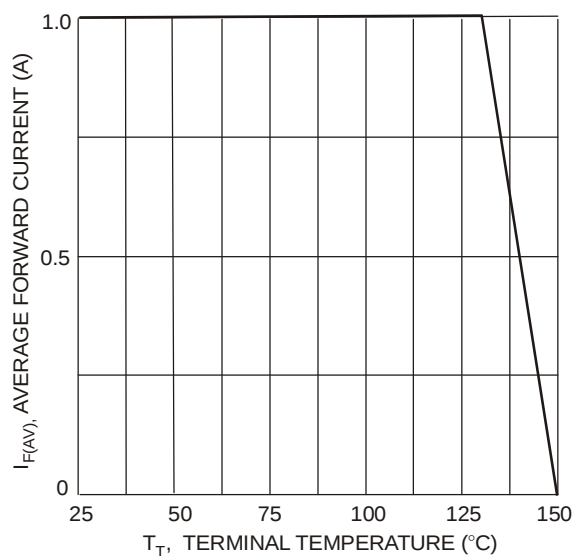


Fig. 3 Forward Current Derating Curve

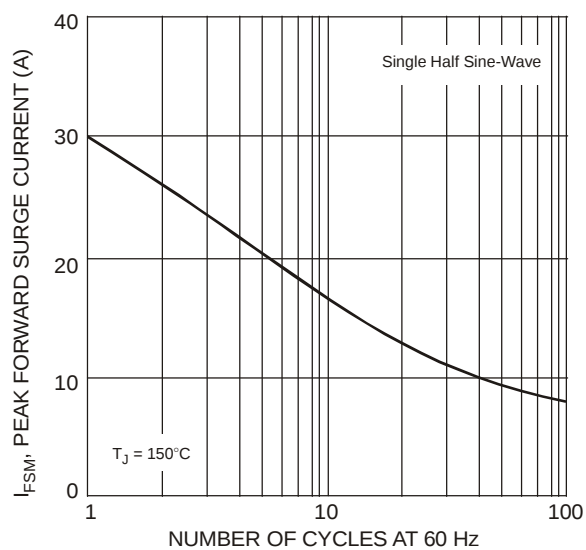
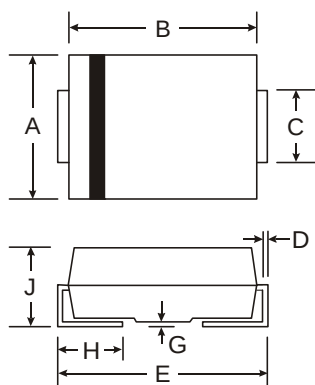


Fig. 4 Max Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current

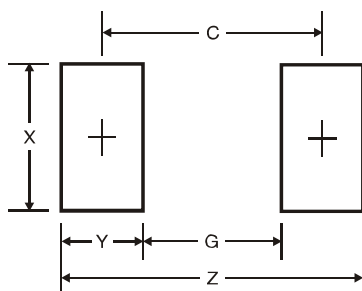
