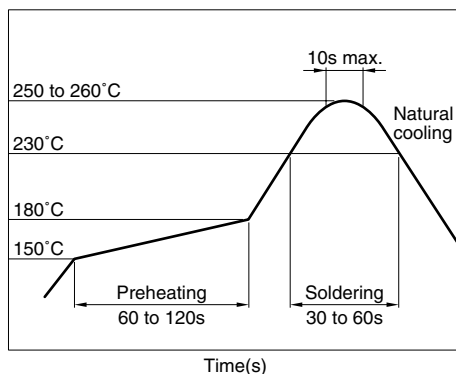

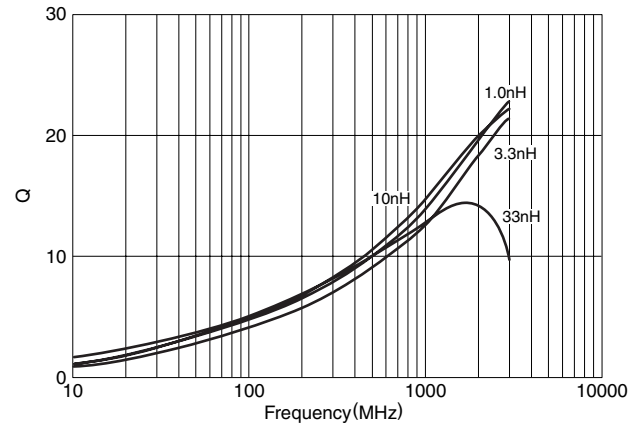

INDUCTANCE vs. FREQUENCY CHARACTERISTICS

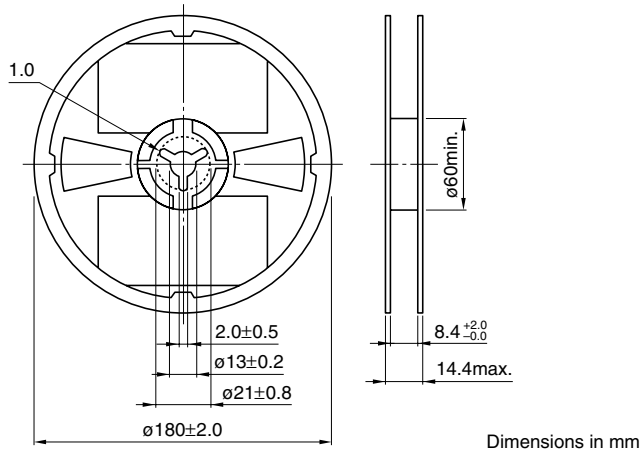


Q vs. FREQUENCY CHARACTERISTICS

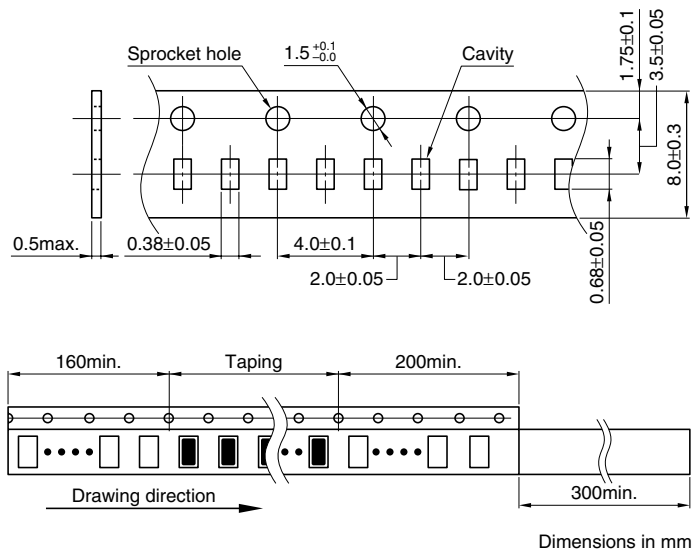

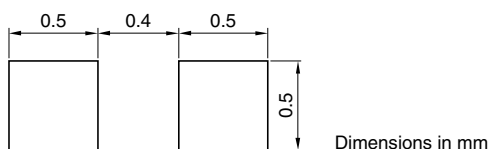

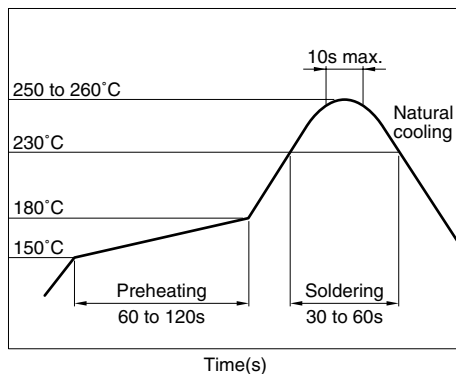
SHAPES AND DIMENSIONS

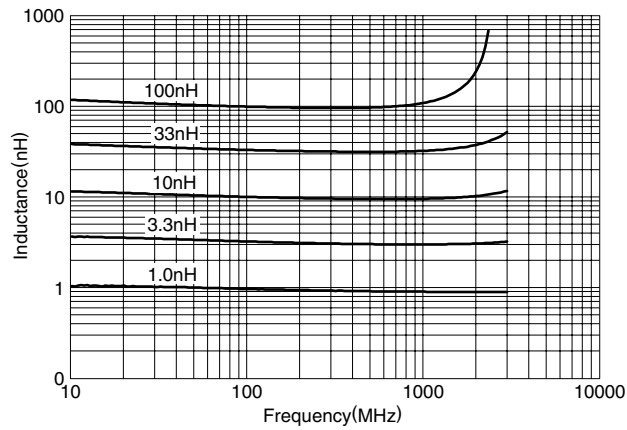

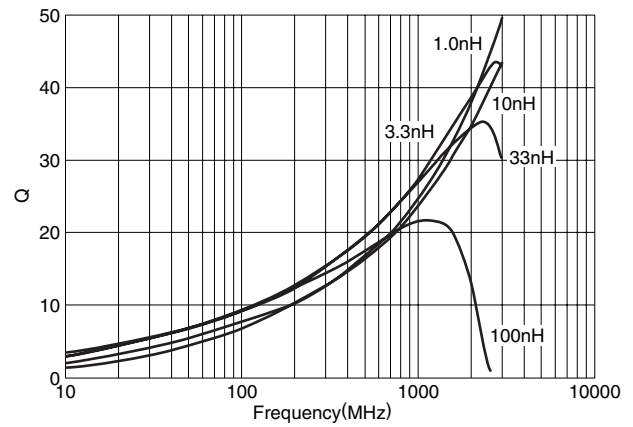

INDUCTANCE vs. FREQUENCY CHARACTERISTICS

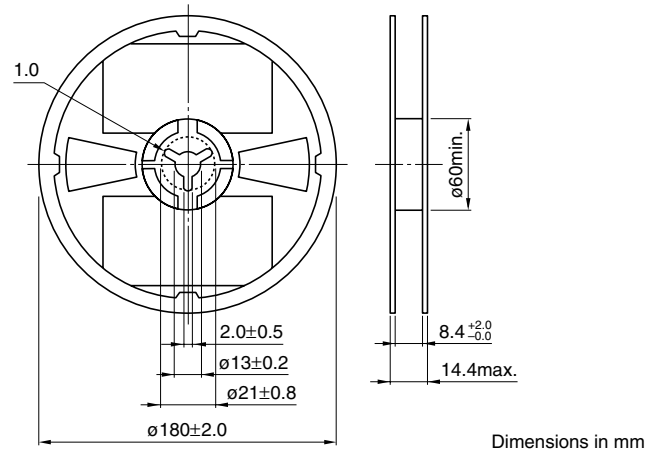


Q vs. FREQUENCY CHARACTERISTICS
